The District is seeking to fill a vacancy on its governing board through the beginning of December 2024. If you are willing to learn, have a desire to serve your community, and are a resident of the Voting District 5 area shown below, we would like to hear from you. The Goleta Sanitary District is an award-winning water resource recovery agency that collects, purifies, and reclaims water, energy, and nutrients from wastewater. We own and operate a collection system comprised of over 132 miles of underground pipes, and a regional waste water recovery facility that has served entire Goleta Valley community through established agreements with the Goleta West Sanitary District, UCSB, the County of Santa Barbara, and the Santa Barbara Municipal Airport for over 80 years. Voting District 5 is located between South Side of Hollister, from Fairview Avenue to Puente Drive. Applicants must live within this area to be appointed to this vacant position on the Board.

Board meetings are typically held the first and third Mondays of the month at 6:30 pm and last between 1.5 to 2 hours. Board members also participate on one or more standing committees that meet on average once a month and are compensated for attending meetings. Through our onboarding process you will learn about special district governance, the responsibilities of a special district Board member, laws governing special districts, the history of our district, budgeting, and much more. You do not need to have any knowledge of wastewater (though it would be great), you just need your experience and enthusiasm for public service.
